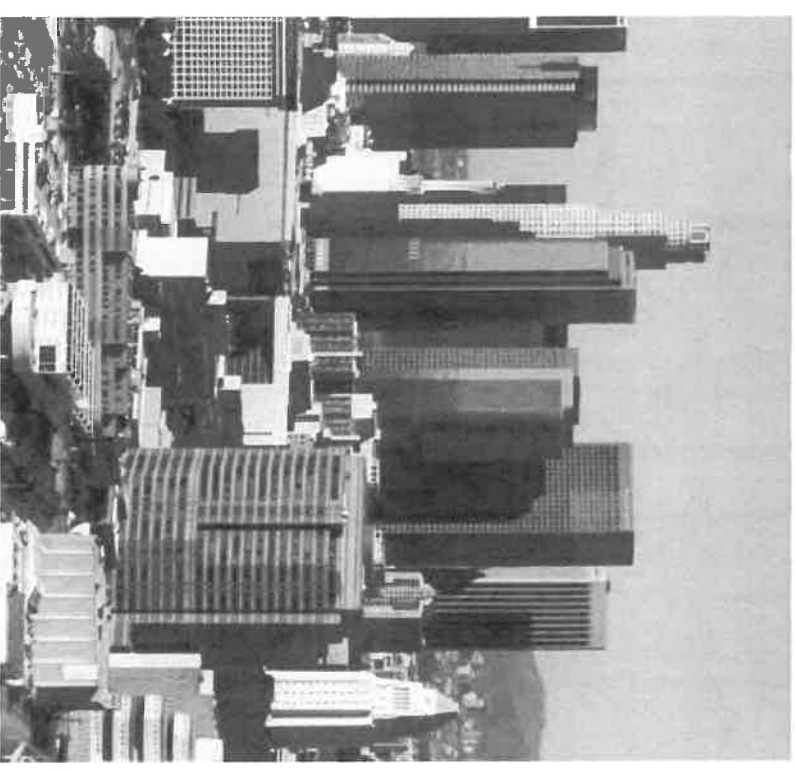

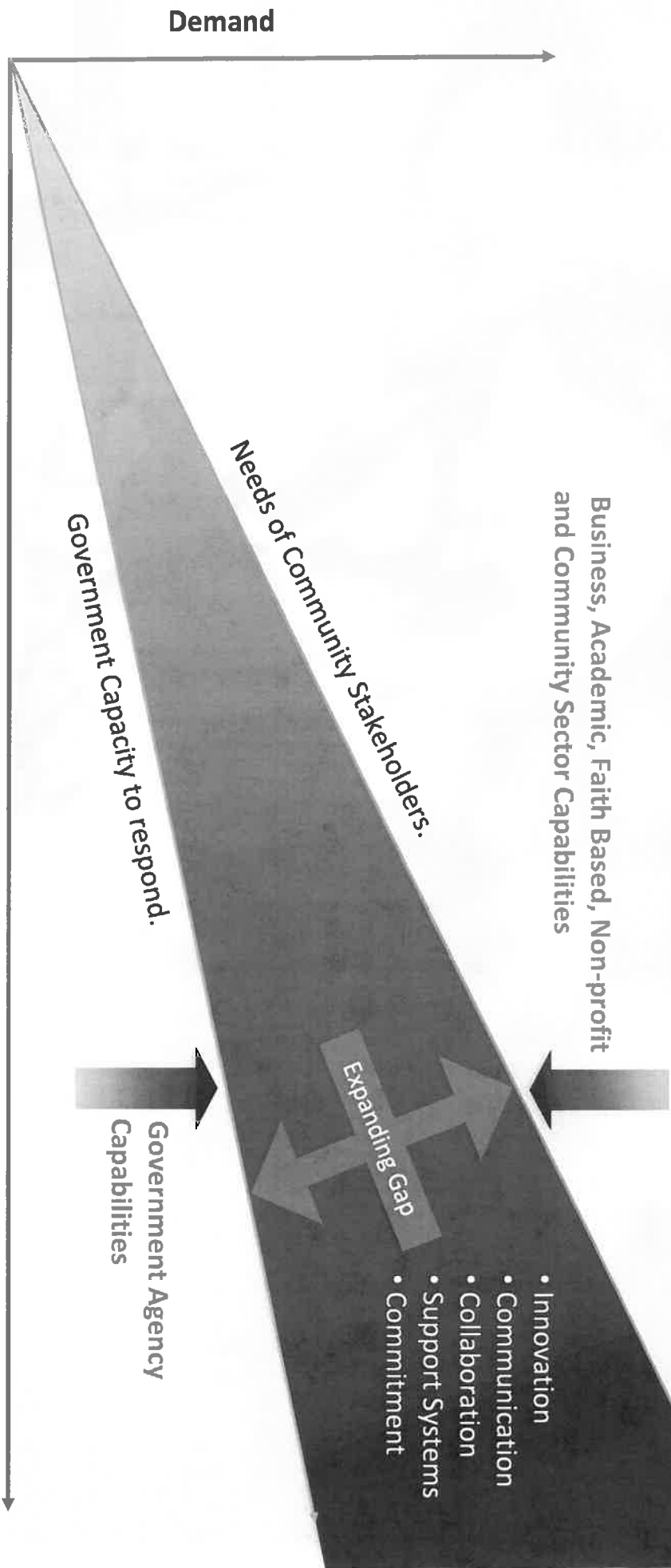

Natural Hazard Mitigation Saves

- US Congressional independent study to assess the future savings from Mitigation Activities.
- Developed in cooperation with Office of Management and Budget and the Congressional Research Office.
- Presented to Congress – report and testimony available
- Industry Benchmark – global standard

Average Benefit of Investing
In Pre-Disaster Mitigation

4:1 Benefit / Cost

Non-structural mitigation achieved a high of 60:1 Benefit/Cost ratio

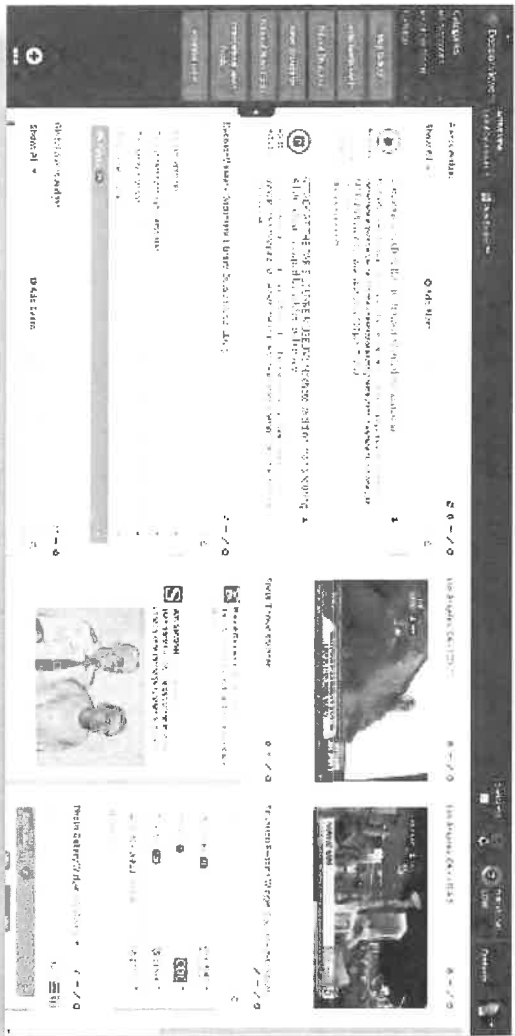
BOC - Incident Management Support System

Provides structure and stability to effectively manage a high stress situation.

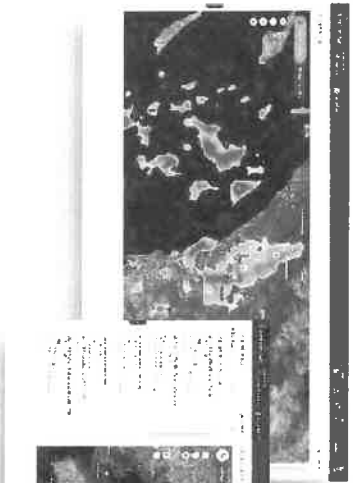

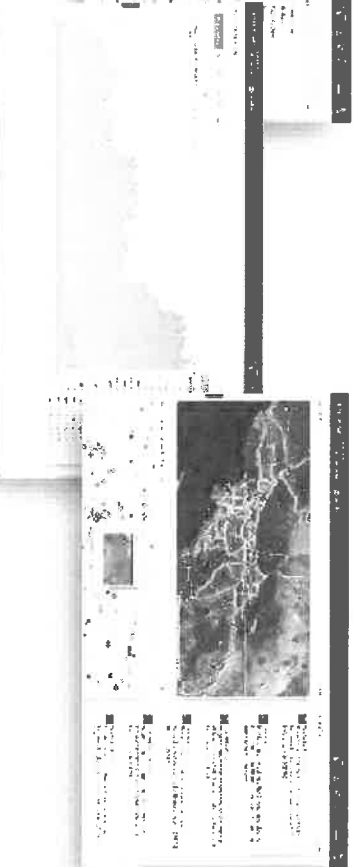
